The Southern Tier HealthLinkNY invites the community to visit its offices in the former Lackawanna Train Station to view an exhibition of unique artistic dolls by local artist Sara Doane. On display will be her collection of sculpture dolls and portraits inspired by the Victorian era and 19th Century spirits. Her designs creatively balance Victoriana, 19th Century mourning practices, and Steam Punk culture with a sense of whimsy.

Born and raised in Upstate New York, Sara is a graduate of Binghamton University and has taught at several local museums and at The Art School in Vestal. As a women’s historian, Sara is fascinated by 19th Century Architecture and the individuals who occupied such places. Through short stories, Sara brings each piece to life for the viewer; she will host the First Friday event in Victorian era costume and offer insights and stories of the period.
