Southern Tier HealthLink NY invites you to come and experience the virtual world of Second Life through our healthcare education project: NY Healthscape. Using 3D avatars, visitors can participate in the interactive healthcare scenarios (both everyday and emergency situations) that STHL has created to illustrate the benefits of a health information exchange.

In addition, on display will be photographic images taken within Second Life, where images can be captured in ways not possible in the real world. The collection will focus on the architecture and landscapes created to depict Binghamton in the early 20th Century, including the former Lackawanna Train Station.
